3 **Resolution urging Governor Gray Davis to adopt Senate Bill 1125, introduced by John**
4 **Burton, which will give farm workers the ability to recover appropriate monetary relief**
5 **for all labor violations and will encourage surety bond companies to undertake greater**
6 **scrutiny of contractors that are issued wage bonds.**

8 WHEREAS, The late Cesar E. Chavez founded the United Farm Workers (“UFW”) to
9 advocate for the rights of California farm workers; and,

10 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has a substantial interest in
11 protecting the rights and livelihood of California’s farm workers; and,

12 WHEREAS, San Francisco has substantial interest in protecting its citizens from labor
13 violations, resulting from violation of farm labor contractor law; interest on wages, and
14 violation of Wage Orders of the Industrial Welfare Commission; and,

15 WHEREAS, The members of the Board of Supervisors support the ongoing effort of the
16 United Farm Workers union to resolve its labor contract negotiations with California growers;
17 now, therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
19 does hereby support the passage of Senate Bill 1125; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby ask that Governor
21 Gray Davis support the passage of Senate Bill 1125, to protect the rights and livelihood of
22 California’s farm workers; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby ask that copies of
24 this legislation be sent to our state representatives and His Honor the Mayor, with instructions
25 that all actions be taken for its successful passage.


