WHEREAS, The Tenderloin is the most densely populated neighborhood in San Francisco and also has the highest concentration of poverty; and,

WHEREAS, TNDC has tackled these issues by providing safe, affordable housing with support services in downtown San Francisco for over 10 years; and,

WHEREAS, Not only is TNDC a leader in preserving affordable housing, it also works to improve the neighborhood through renovation and socially responsible development; and,

WHEREAS, TNDC owns and operates over 20 buildings and serves over 3,000 tenants and 1, 568 in small homes; and

WHEREAS, Most recently, TNDC added three senior buildings which protected the rents from going market rate and prevented hundreds of low-income seniors from losing their homes; and,

WHEREAS, Utilizing comprehensive approaches to low-income housing, TNDC provides services through on-site social workers and their innovative Neighborhood Employment and Training Program; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby commends Tenderloin Neighborhood Development Corporation for providing affordable housing to low-income communities in San Francisco.
