3 **Resolution authorizing the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice (MOCJ) to retroactively**
4 **accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$599,102 from the Office of Justice**
5 **Programs (OJP), Violence Against Women Office (VAWO) for the purpose of**
6 **encouraging policies that treat domestic violence and sexual assault as serious**
7 **violations of criminal law.**

9 WHEREAS, MOCJ is the lead programmatic and fiscal agency in administering the
10 VAWO grant; and

11 WHEREAS, San Francisco applied and was awarded on August 22, 2002, five hundred
12 ninety-nine thousand, one hundred and two dollars (\$599,102); and,

13 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff's Department, District Attorney's Office and
14 Department on the Status of Women will be responsible for all day to day operations of the
15 three components of this grant; and

16 WHEREAS, MOCJ will be responsible for the fiscal and programmatic reporting to
17 OJP; and


18 WHEREAS, In order to maximize direct services indirect costs are requested to be
19 waived; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to
21 retroactively accept and expend \$599,102 from VAWO, Office of Justice Programs, to
22 administer the Grant to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders
23 Program; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the two positions authorized under the grant are to be
designated as "G" or grant funded positions which would terminate when grant expires.





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
