Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Community Behavioral Health, Comprehensive Child Crisis Services (SFDPH, CBH, CCCS) (Provider) to enter retroactively into an agreement which includes a mutual indemnification clause and a binding arbitration clause, with Managed Health Network, Inc. (MHN) (Primary Contractor) to provide comprehensive child crisis services at a capitated rate to MHN enrollees for total estimated revenues of \$100,000 for the 16 22 month period of March 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005.

WHEREAS, MHN has requested that SFDPH, CBH, CCCS enter into an agreement to provide comprehensive child crisis services to MHN enrollees at a capitated rate; and,

WHEREAS, MHN has agreed to reimburse SFDPH, CBH, CCCS in the estimated amount of \$75,000 per year, for the period of March 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005, for total estimated revenues of \$100,000; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds MHN requires SFDPH, CBH, CCCS to enter into an agreement (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 040481, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, Services will be provided as clinically appropriate/as needed and the revenue received in payment for these services will be used to offset all appropriate and allowable costs, based on the rate schedule negotiated between SFDPH, CBH, CCCS and MHN and included in the contractual document as Appendix M; and,

WHEREAS, The City Attorney has reviewed the agreement and its mutual indemnification and binding arbitration clauses; and,

WHEREAS, The agreement prohibits including indirect costs in the provider's budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That SFDPH, CBH, CCCS. is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into an agreement for total estimated revenues of \$100,000 with MHN, the primary contractor; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the budget of the agreement; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provisions in the agreement pursuant to mutual indemnification and binding arbitration; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
