## RESOLUTION NO. 293-04

[Establishing Accessible Voting Systems for November 2004 Elections]

Resolution directing the Department of Elections to immediately determine the cost of implementing touch screen voting systems for the disabled for the November 2004 election.

WHEREAS, Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) voting machines presently provide the greatest level of accessibility to the disability community; and,

WHEREAS, Fourteen counties in California are currently using these accessible DRE touch screen systems; and

WHEREAS, The current San Francisco vendor, ES&S, has the accessible DRE touch screen system available, and the system is certified by the Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, Approximately 51,000 voting age residents in the City and County of San Francisco have vision or upper body disabilities that make it difficult or impossible to vote independently with the current optical scan voting system; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Elections has told the disability community that it would make available of DRE touch screen systems since 2001, but has yet to do so; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco is spending staff time and city resources in upgrading the current technology; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Department of Elections to advise the Board, as soon as possible, and in any case no later than May 18, 2004, in writing, of the cost of and procedures required to place one DRE touch screen machine in
