7 WHEREAS, In 1971 a visionary group of women founded San Francisco Women's
8 Centers which evolved into the Women's Building in 1979 with the purchase of Dovre Hall on
9 Eighteenth Street in the Mission; and

10 WHEREAS, The Women's Building was the nation's first women-owned and operated
11 community center, with its roots in the feminist movement; and,

12 WHEREAS, Its mission to provide women and girls with tools and resources for social
13 equality and successful self-sufficiency has endured and flourished for a quarter of a century;
14 and,

15 WHEREAS, The Women's Building offers a breadth of services: fostering financial
16 literacy, job search skills and college preparation for first-generation higher education
17 students, among others; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Women's Building facilities also serve a vital community role, hosting
19 cultural and educational forums, workshops, support groups and recreational activities; and,

20 WHEREAS, Its facilities also provide affordable office space to non-profit
21 organizations; and,

22 WHEREAS, The Women's Building continues to further its vision to develop the next
23 generation of leaders with its Young Women's Initiative; now, therefore, be it




