[Requesting DTIS to Evaluate and Make Recommendations on Stolen Vehicles.]

Resolution requesting the Department of Telecommunications and Information Services (DTIS) to evaluate and make recommendations on the needed steps so that the San Francisco Department of Parking and Traffic and Police Department can share data on stolen vehicles.

WHEREAS, San Francisco has over 8,000 vehicles reported stolen each year; and WHEREAS, Stolen vehicles are frequently recovered after being abandoned on City Streets with numerous parking tickets accumulated; and,

WHEREAS, The City currently does not employ technology to allow for easy exchange of data and information between the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) and the Department of Parking and Traffic (DPT) about stolen vehicles as well as citations issued to vehicles that have been reported stolen; and,

WHEREAS, The absence of technological coordination and compatibility delays recovery of hundreds of vehicles on a more timely basis and creates understandable frustration from owners of these vehicles who later receive numerous parking tickets; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the Department of Telecommunications and Information Services (DTIS) to evaluate and report to the Board of Supervisors, with copies to the Board of the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) and the San Francisco Police Commission, on the needed steps and costs to enable SFPD and DPT to make their information technologies compatible and linked to immediately exchange information on stolen vehicles.
