RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors has reviewed and approves the Director of the Department of Public Works' recommendation contained in Department of Public Works Order No.174,862, dated June 16, 2004; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the new agreement and the options extending the seven other agreements, designates the actions extending the agreements as retroactive to the date of their respective terminations, and extend all of the agreements beyond their one-year terms; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors authorizes all actions heretofore taken by the officers of the City with respect to this Resolution and hereby approves, confirms and ratifies such actions. This Board also authorizes and directs the Mayor, Clerk of the Board, Director of Property, and Director of Public Works to take any and all actions that they or the City Attorney may deem necessary or advisable in order to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Resolution including, without limitation, the recordation of any agreements or evidence of such extension(s) in the Official Records of the City and County of San Francisco.
