WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors because we did not receive the award until September 9, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$33,315; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend grant funding in the amount of \$267,880 from CDC; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to add two new positions, totaling 2.0 ftes; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
