6 WHEREAS, Since 1997, The Metropolitan Community Foundation (MCF) has  
7 provided food, showers and practical survival support services to thousands of San  
8 Francisco's most impoverished, underserved and marginalized communities, and

9 WHEREAS, These communities include homeless individuals and families of all  
10 ages, ranging from young children to seniors, individuals living with HIV/AIDS, and  
11 individuals escaping domestic violence, physical violence and discrimination, and

12 WHEREAS, MCF is an exemplary neighborhood organization, community member  
13 and philanthropic non-profit that serve individuals entrapped in extreme poverty in the  
14 Castro and Mission neighborhoods, and

15 WHEREAS, MCF mobilizes hundreds of volunteers that reflect the diversity of the  
16 City to augment minimal staff at the foundation and to assist providing services to needy,  
and

17 WHEREAS, Renewed funding and the continuation of this critical Shower program  
18 will reduce the suffering of the City's most vulnerable citizens and provide a crucial  
19 springboard to transition individuals and families from homelessness to permanent housing  
20 and adequate social, educational and employment services; now therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
22 **Urging the Mayor's Office of Community Development to fully renew funding for**  
23 **Metropolitan Community Foundation's Shower Project and to fully fund its new case**  
24 **management program.**




