WHEREAS, The celebration of the contributions of African Americans was lengthened to include the entire month of February in 1976 as part of the United States' Bicentennial celebration; and,

WHEREAS, The month of February is also significant for the birthdays of great African American pioneers and institutions, including W.E.B. DuBois, Langston Hughes, Eubie Blake, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, and the first Pan African Congress; and,

WHEREAS, February is now nationally recognized as Black History Month throughout the United States and various parts of the world; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco recognizes the month of February as Black History Month.
