3 **Resolution enacting bike lanes and other traffic regulations on Oakdale Avenue.**

5 RESOLVED, That in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and
6 the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles
7 and bicycles are hereby enacted as designated below:

9 **BIKE LANES - ESTABLISH**

10 Oakdale Avenue, both directions, from Bayshore Boulevard to Selby Street.

12 **TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING ANYTIME - ESTABLISH**

13 Oakdale Avenue, northside, from Selby Street to 175' easterly.

14 Oakdale Avenue, southside, from Patterson Street to 100' east of Loomis Street.

15
16 **LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT - ESTABLISH**

17 Oakdale Avenue, eastbound, approaching Selby Street.

21 *Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and*
22 *parking regulations where such changes do not*
23 *establish a higher speed limit or result in more*
24 *than a negligible increase in the use of the*
25 *street.*
