Resolution supporting the WorldPride celebration in Jerusalem.

WHEREAS, WorldPride 2005, a ten-day festival celebrating the pride of the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender communities in the Middle East and throughout the world, will be held in Jerusalem from August 18-28th, 2005; and

WHEREAS, WorldPride is sponsored by Jerusalem Open House, an incredible grassroots civil rights organization leading the movement for the rights of the LGBT Community in Israel since 1998; and

WHEREAS, Jerusalem Open House is the largest producer of Arabic language materials about LGBT issues, and has a full-time outreach coordinator for the Palestinian LGBT community; and

WHEREAS, The first WorldPride celebration was held in Rome in 2000, in order to bring the message to the world religious leaders that Gays and Lesbians are a vital part of humanity; and

WHEREAS, On March 31st Israel's two chief rabbis, patriarchs of Roman Catholic, Greek Orthodox, and Armenian churches, and three Muslim prayer leaders held a rare joint press conference asking Jerusalem's city government to prevent WorldPride from happening; and

WHEREAS, These religious leaders have made extreme homophobic statements regarding the WorldPride celebration such as, "This is very ugly and very nasty to have these people come to Jerusalem," and that the celebration is "creating a deep and terrible sorrow that is unbearable;" and

WHEREAS, Opposition rhetoric has escalated into violence, with Jerusalem's only LGBT bar, owned by the openly gay member of Jerusalem's city council, suffered extensive fire damage and is closed for repairs after a man entered the doorway of the club and threw a burning rag inside; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco is a leader in the fight for human rights for all people, and has been vocal about the need for inclusive and safe spaces for people from all ethnic, religious, cultural, and sexual communities; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors supports the right of the LGBT community to gather and celebrate WorldPride in Jerusalem; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors condemns the acts of hatred, discrimination, and homophobia displayed by the world's religious community in regard to the WorldPride celebration.
