3 **Resolution extending Early Retirement Program for and through fiscal years 2005-06**  
4 **and 2006-07.**

6 WHEREAS the voters approved Charter section A8.401 in November 2003 authorizing  
7 an early retirement program for fiscal years 2003-2004 and 2004-2005;

8 WHEREAS Charter section A8.401 was designed to mitigate the impact of layoffs  
9 necessitated by anticipated budgetary shortfalls in those fiscal years;

10 WHEREAS Charter section A8.401-7 provides that, "This program may be extended by  
11 three-fourths vote of the Board of Supervisors. The Board may authorize an extension limited  
12 to fiscal years 2005-2006 and 2006-2007";

13 WHEREAS the City anticipates a significant budgetary shortfall for fiscal year 2005-  
14 2006;

15 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Early Retirement Program set forth in  
16 Charter Section A8.401 is hereby extended for and through fiscal year 2005-06.




