WHEREAS, A Court of Appeals opinion in litigation entitled <u>Action Apartment</u> <u>Association v. City of Santa Monica (Court of Appeal No. B16581) invalidated a portion of the</u> City of Santa Monica's rent ordinance which provided for relief against wrongful eviction; and,

WHEREAS, The California Supreme Court has granted the City of Santa Monica's petition for review of the opinion in <u>Action Apartment Association</u> and is presently considering arguments presented by the parties and the public; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has an interest in preserving its authority to provide protections to its residents against wrongful evictions as set forth in the city's Rent Stabilization and Arbitration Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco may request the court to consider a friend of the court brief to set forth its interest in providing protections and remedies for its residents against wrongful evictions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco should seek leave of court to file a 'friend of the court'/amicus curiae brief to set forth our city's interest in protecting tenants against wrongful evictions; and, be it
