Resolution in support of House Resolution 367 condemning bigotry, violence and discrimination against Iranian-Americans.

WHEREAS, Iranian-Americans serve as government officials, in the military, and law enforcement, working to uphold the constitution of the United States and to protect all Americans; and

WHEREAS, Iranian-Americans are vibrant, peaceful and law-abiding citizens and residents of the Baha'l, Christian, Jewish, Muslim and Zoroastrian faiths, or are non-religious; and,

WHEREAS, Iranian-Americans have greatly contributed to the social and economic fabric of American society; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is seriously concerned regarding the findings, in the report of the Inspector General of the Department of Justice, of arrests followed by detentions for extended periods of time without charges, denials of access to counsel, and abuse by prison guards of nationals of Iranian origin following the attacks of September 11th, 2001; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is seriously concerned regarding the findings in that report of discriminatory enforcement of the immigration laws, leading to arbitrary detentions and deportations of nationals of Iranian origin; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is seriously concerned by the alarming number of reports of incidents of discrimination and bias-motivated crime against Americans of Middle

SUPERVISOR MIRKARIMI BOARD OF SUPERVISORS Eastern descent, including Iranian-Americans, all across the Nation in the wake of the tragic events of September 11th, 2001; and,

WHEREAS, Representative Meehan, Representative Shays, Representative Mica, and Representative Feeney have introduced a House Resolution 367 in the United States House of Representatives declaring that the government should ensure civil rights and civil liberties protections for Iranian-Americans, condemns bigotry against any Americans, including Iranian-Americans, encourages Iranian-Americans, encourages Iranian-Americans to share their experiences with local, State and Federal elected officials as well as others to end stereotypes, correct misconceptions and convey instances of abuse against the Iranian-American community, and calls upon local, State and Federal law enforcement authorities to investigate and vigorously prosecute crimes committed against all Americans, including Iranian-Americans that are based on actual or perceived race, color, religion, national origin or ethnicity; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That The San Francisco Board of Supervisors commends Representative Meehan, Representative Shays, Representative Mica, and Representative Feeney for introducing House Resolution 367; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco Police Commission to take steps to ensure that the San Francisco Police Department protects all San Franciscans from discrimination, especially those of South Asia (Middle Eastern) and Iranian descent most at risk due to the prejudicial misperceptions of culpability prevalent in the wake of the September 11th attacks; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That The San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the United States House of Representatives to pass House Resolution 367; and, be it
