WHEREAS, August 2005 marks the 85th anniversary of the ratification of the 19th amendment to the United States Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, The 19th amendment guarantees all women who are United States citizens the right to vote by declaring that the right to vote not be denied or abridged on account of sex; and,

WHEREAS, The passage of the 19th amendment is a historic victory resulting from decades of agitation, protest and struggle; and,

WHEREAS, Beginning in the mid-19th century, several generations of women's suffrage supporters lectured, wrote, marched, lobbied and practiced civil disobedience to achieve what many Americans considered a radical change of the United States Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, Few early supporters lived to see their final victory in 1920 with the passage of the 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, The Anniversary of the passage of the 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution is celebrated by women's rights organizations across the United States through events emphasizing solidarity, unity and empowerment; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the 85th anniversary of the 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution, extending the right of suffrage to women.
