WHEREAS, The Blue Shield Foundation of California's mission is to contribute to the health of Californians through direct support and partnerships with organizations that find solutions to community needs; and

WHEREAS, The Justice and Courage Oversight Panel of the Commission on the Status of Women has identified culturally competent training of San Francisco criminal justice agencies to be a significant and priority need; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Department on the Status of Women (DOSW) is requesting support in the amount of \$200,000 from the Blue Shield Foundation for a Domestic Violence Cross-Training Institute (Institute), an innovative initiative designed to use domestic violence advocates from community-based organizations to provide interactive and culturally competent training for San Francisco criminal justice agencies; and

WHEREAS, The establishment of the Institute will ensure that criminal justice staff from the Adult Probation Department, Juvenile Probation Department, District Attorney's Office, Emergency Communications Department (911), Police Department, and members of the Superior Court, are trained on domestic violence in a uniform manner, using a more costeffective approach; and

WHEREAS, Through the Institute, staff from these agencies will be trained to enhance domestic violence victim and survivor safety, reduce homicides related to domestic violence, and increase abuser accountability; and

WHEREAS, Public-private partnerships have already proven effective in a number of key policy areas and a partnership between the DOSW and the Blue Shield Foundation of California would be a step toward realizing both organizations' vision of a California free from intimate partner and family violence; and, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors supports the DOSW proposal to the Blue Shield Foundation for funding to support the development of a Domestic Violence Cross-Training Institute; and be it
