WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco is dedicated to the improvement of pedestrian and traffic safety; and,

WHEREAS, preventing pedestrian and traffic injuries and deaths requires the effective use of evidence-based intervention strategies; and,

WHEREAS, the implementation of comprehensive approaches combining injury surveillance, community-based interventions, traffic engineering, law enforcement, educational campaigns, public policies, and evaluation will be the most effective way to change social norms regarding traffic safety; and,

WHEREAS, 19th Avenue (Highway 1) is a State Highway owned and operated by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) as a six-lane highway serving both regional and local traffic; and,

WHEREAS, Caltrans Phase I Signal Upgrade Construction includes: (1) new traffic signals that will be more visible to motorists and provide for smoother traffic flow and greater safety; (2) pedestrian signals with countdown timers, telling pedestrians how much time they have to safely cross the street; and (3) new curb ramps directing pedestrians to the crosswalks; and,

WHEREAS, specific intersection to be upgraded as a part of Phase I include: (1) Geary Boulevard; (2) Crossover Drive/Lincoln Way; (3) Irving Street; (4) Judah Street; (5) Noriega Street; (5) Quintara Street; (6) Taraval Street; (7) Vicente Street; (8) Ocean Avenue; (9)

Eucalyptus Drive; (10) Holloway Avenue; and (11) Junipero Serra Boulevard; now, therefore, be it
