Jason Oringer, new appointment, seat 1, must have significant experience representing employees in labor matters, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 17, 2007.

Alicia Culver (residency requirement waived), new appointment, seat 2, must have significant experience acquiring goods or services for a public entity, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 17, 2007.

Abigail Levine, new appointment, seat 3, must have significant experience as an advocate for human rights or the poor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 17, 2007.

Laura Juran, new appointment, seat 4, must be a member of the public, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 17, 2007.
