3 **Resolution supporting SB 1414, the California Fair Share Health Care Act.**

5 WHEREAS, On February 22, 2006, State Senator Carole Migden introduced SB 1414,  
6 also known as the "California Fair Share Health Care Act," which has been referred to the  
7 Senate Health Committee; and

8 WHEREAS, The bill would require an employer with 10,000 or more employees in the  
9 state to spend a specified percentage of the total wages the employer pays to ensure that  
10 these Californians receive healthcare; and,

11 WHEREAS, The state of Maryland has enacted a similar law, overriding a veto of that  
12 state's governor; and,

13 WHEREAS, A copy of SB 1414 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in  
14 File No. 060383, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein;  
15 and,

16 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has long stood for providing  
17 accessible, affordable, quality healthcare to our residents; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco supports Senate Bill 1414 and  
19 urges its swift passage and approval by the Governor; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board  
21 to forward a copy of this resolution to members of our state legislative delegation.


