RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend five grants in the total amount of \$11,122.63 from the CDFA and CDPR; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the budget of the four Agreements, where prohibited; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreements on behalf of the City.
