[Add Sunday hours at neighborhood branch libraries.]

Resolution urging the Library Commission to add Sunday hours at neighborhood branch libraries.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Library system consists of a Main Library and twenty-seven neighborhood branch libraries; and

WHEREAS, Nineteen neighborhood branch libraries are being renovated and five new neighborhood branch libraries are being constructed under the Branch Library Improvement Program (BLIP); and

WHEREAS, Five neighborhood branch libraries are currently closed for BLIP-funded seismic reinforcement, accessibility improvements and modernization; and

WHEREAS, The Main Library and five neighborhood branch libraries- Chinatown. Excelsior, Mission and Richmond- have permanent Sunday hours and the Merced, North Beach and Parkside neighborhood branch libraries have temporary Sunday hours while neighboring branches are closed for renovation; and

WHEREAS, Fifteen of the twenty-seven neighborhood branch libraries, including seven of the nine neighborhood branch libraries serving the City's southeastern neighborhoods, are closed on Sundays. (i.e. Mission and Excelsior branches are open on Sundays while Potrero. Bernal Heights, Bayview/Anna E. Waden, Portola, Visitation Valley, Ocean View and Ingleside branches are closed on Sundays and most are also closed on Mondays); and

WHEREAS, System wide Sunday hours in San Francisco neighborhood branch libraries would enable persons whose circumstances prevent them from using their neighborhood branch library during current weekday or Saturday hours or from traveling to the Main or a branch facility open on Sundays to access library services, would maximize the

availability of library materials and resources to all San Franciscans, and would further the Library system's stated mission to ensure: "free and equal access to information, knowledge, independent learning, and the joys of reading for our diverse community;" and

WHEREAS, Under the City Charter, the Library Commission establishes the hours of operation for the Main Library and its branches; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Library Commission to establish permanent Sunday service hours throughout the neighborhood branch library system; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Library Commission to allocate funds from its current fiscal year budget to add Sunday hours at least to a neighborhood branch library located in one or more of the City's southeastern neighborhoods, giving particular consideration to the new Ocean View Branch which opened in 2000 and will not be closed for renovations; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That, to the extent that the Library Commission currently lacks funding to establish permanent Sunday hours in all neighborhood branch libraries, the Board of Supervisors urges the Library Commission to add permanent Sunday hours as funding permits to branch neighborhood libraries on an equitable basis, taking into consideration the geographic and demographic factors of each branch, to the end that San Franciscans of all socioeconomic and cultural backgrounds in every neighborhood throughout the City will have access to a nearby branch library on Sundays; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Library Commission to add temporary Sunday hours to the service hours at neighborhood branch libraries where the Library is adding hours to accommodate temporary closure of neighboring branches for renovations; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Library measure issuance of library cards and branch usage during Sunday service hours at neighborhood branch libraries where the Library Commission has added Sunday hours under this Resolution and report back on such usage to the Board of Supervisors.
