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Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend \$49,000 of Regional Measure 2 funds for Safe Routes to Transit project.

WHEREAS, On March 2, 2004, voters in seven Bay Area counties cumulatively passed Regional Measure 2, which imposed a \$1.00 toll on the nine State-owned toll bridges in the San Francisco Bay Area effective July 1, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, Regional Measure 2 will raise an estimated \$125 million each year to implement the Regional Traffic Relief Plan, which includes transit operating assistance and funding of specified capital projects within the region that have been determined to reduce congestion or make improvements to travel in the toll bridge corridors; and

WHEREAS, Regional Measure 2 allocates \$20 million for Safe Routes to Transit projects that involve the planning and construction of bicycle and pedestrian access improvements in close proximity to transit facilities; and

WHEREAS, As the transportation planning, coordinating and financing agency of the nine-county Bay Area, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) allocates Regional Measure 2 funding; and.

WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency of the City and County of San Francisco (MTA) is an eligible sponsor of transportation project(s) using Regional Measure 2, Regional Traffic Relief Plan funds; and

WHEREAS, The MTA has applied to MTC for \$49,000 in Safe Routes to Transit funding to conduct planning and environmental activities for a project to improve bicycle access to the 16th Street BART Station; and

WHEREAS, The MTA's Safe Routes to Transit project is eligible for consideration in the Regional Traffic Relief Plan of Regional Measure 2, as identified in California Streets and Highways Code Section 30914(c) or (d); and

WHEREAS, There is no allowance for indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; now, therefore be it RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend \$49,000 of available Regional Measure 2 funds to conduct planning and environmental activities for a project to improve bicycle access to the 16<sup>th</sup> Street BART Station; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional information as may be requested by the funding agency in connection with this request; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any and all agreements necessary to complete transfer of the funds.
