Resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to apply for, accept and expend \$708,333 in funds from the Division of Community Partnerships through the Intergovernmental Partnership (IGP) Grant Program to fund the implementation and expansion of innovative programs designed to reduce recidivism and prevent community victimization; waiving any indirect costs.

WHEREAS, The IGP Grant Program was created to enhance local government collaboration to develop strategies for safer communities through effective programs and services. This program creates opportunities for collaboration and provides incentives to encourage the participation of key stakeholders in offender program planning and reintegration; and,

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs; now therefore, be

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive indirect costs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the funds received will target adult offenders returning to the City and County of San Francisco from state correctional institutions; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will not supplant IGP Grant funds; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will participate in the data collection on key variables related to recidivism and quality of life outcomes as required; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Sheriff's Department is authorized to furnish whatever additional information or assurances the funding agency may request in connection with this grant, and execute any and all agreements necessary to complete the transfer of funds. The grant period is from February 01, 2007 to June 30, 2008; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco assures that it will abide by the statues governing the IGP grant program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the Division of Community Partnerships.
