Resolution establishing temporary occupancy of a portion of the commercial vehicle parking meters on the north side of Post Street between Kearny and Montgomery from 8:30am to 5:00pm on every Thursday beginning January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.

WHEREAS, Farmers' markets provide the opportunity for consumers to purchase fresh organic fruits and vegetables; and

WHEREAS, Farmers' markets create opportunities for market goers to gather together and help enhance a sense of community within a neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Increasing walking traffic in neighborhood commercial districts tends to enhance the overall economic vitality of the district; and

WHEREAS, Food sold and purchased at farmers' markets travels a shorter distance from field to table than most food in the grocery store thus saving fuel and helping to protect the environment; and

WHEREAS, The Sustainability Plan for the City and County of San Francisco, adopted by the Board of Supervisors in 1997, lists access to nutritious, affordable, and safe food as a principle goal; and

WHEREAS, The Sustainability Plan identifies creating farmers' markets in every neighborhood in San Francisco as a long-term objective; and,

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Certified Farmers' Market at the Crocker Galleria would provide residents with access to fruits and vegetables that will help Financial District market customers meet their nutritional needs; and,

WHEREAS, ISCOTT approval of the temporary occupancy of commercial vehicle parking meters will be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, Section 202.E(3) of the San Francisco Traffic Code sets forth a fee for issuance of permits for exclusive temporary use of parking meters of \$4 per parking meter zone per day, including Sundays and Holidays, a fee which shall be deposited in the Off-Street Parking Fund at the time the permit is issued; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is the appropriate policy body to approve an extended temporary occupancy permit; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulation governing the movement of vehicles is hereby enacted as designated below.

Temporary occupancy of commercial vehicle parking meters, (614-00100, 614-00120, 614-00140, 614-00160, 614-00200, 614-0220, 614-00260, 614-00280, 614-00300, 614-00340) 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Every Thursday Beginning January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007, on the north side of Post Street between Kearny and Montgomery Streets for a Certified Farmers' Market.
