Conditions: (1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight, Sunday through Thursday and 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., Friday and Saturday. (2) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (3) Petitioner shall not permit their patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the sidewalks adjacent to the licensed premises. (4) No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any premises adjacent to the licensed premises with the exception of the patrons whose residences are adjacent to the premises. (5) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensees. (6) No person under the age of twenty-one (21 years of age) shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages. (7) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered, or consumed. (8) No wine shall be sold unless labeled bio-dynamic, sustainable process or organic by the manufacturer. (9) No beer or malt beverages shall be served or sold at this premises.
