WHEREAS, The Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make monies available under the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for mass transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA), City and County of San Francisco is an eligible claimant for FTA Technical Study planning assistance grants under Section 5303 of TEA-21; and

WHEREAS, Section 5303 funds may be used for transit service and capital planning activities; and

WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations on the applicant, including providing the local share (\$11,480) of project costs; and

WHEREAS, The local share of project costs will be provided separately as in-kind services from the MTA, primarily through staff time, funding for which is contained in Muni's FY07 and FY08 operating budgets; and

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) requires the San Francisco Municipal Railway (Muni) to produce a Short Range Transit Plan (SRTP) every four years; and

WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA) Board of Directors adopted Muni's last SRTP in December 2005; and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director/CEO of the MTA (or his designee) must execute agreements to complete transfer of the funds; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and WHEREAS, There is no allowance for indirect costs; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the MTA is

authorized to accept and expend \$86,520 in federal Section 5303 Technical Study Grant planning assistance to develop and produce the FY2008 Short Range Transit Plan; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional information or assurances may be requested by the funding agencies in connection with this request; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any and all agreements necessary to complete transfer of the funds.
