[Declaring May 23, 2007, James Loyce Jr. day in San Francisco.]

WHEREAS, James Loyce Jr. has served the City and County of San Francisco with distinction for over 20 years; and

WHEREAS, his tenure with the City has successfully spanned the reign of five Mayor's and four Health Directors; and

WHEREAS, in his early years with the Department "Jimmy" made a significant contribution to the field of substance abuse services seeking grants totaling more than \$20 million and advocating for sobriety and recovery; and

WHEREAS, for 3 years in the early 90's Mr. Loyce served as the Associate Director of the AIDS Office, and for the past 9 years as Deputy Director of Health and Director of the AIDS Office providing leadership for HIV/AIDS policy, treatment and health services in a City that has born a disproportionate burden of this disease; and

WHEREAS, from 1994 – 1998 Mr. Loyce left CCSF employment to serve as CEO of AIDS Project Los Angeles, where he oversaw the work of the nation's second largest community support organization for persons affected by HIV/AIDS; and

WHEREAS, when Mr. Loyce returned to DPH in 1998 he presided over the Departments efforts to integrate services and is committed to promoting seamless access to services for special populations; and

WHEREAS, over the years Jimmy has lead a number of important initiatives pulling together population specific providers, advocates and consumers to impact public health policy and outcomes; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Loyce served as a staunch advocate for improving the healthcare of the community, successfully working to create effective and compassionate public health policy; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy is retiring from CCSF employment to pursue career options outside DPH, to devote more time to his philanthropic volunteer activities and to spend more time with his family; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby declares May 23, 2007, James Loyce Jr. day in San Francisco.
