WHEREAS, Funding from the Year-Round Feeding Program will enable the City and County of San Francisco's After School Snack Program to provide children with free snacks through 50 After School program sites, providing an average of 1500 children per day with a nutritious snack during After School hours; and

WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit indirect costs; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors herby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families to apply for, accept and expend funds in

the amount of \$876,988, currently and retroactively, from the United States Department of Agriculture to sponsor the 2007 Mayor's Summer Food Service program and After School Snack Program.
