Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Board of Supervisors to accept and expend \$275,000 in AB 471 funds from the California Resources Agency, Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation Program to fund Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and other improvements to Tulare Park

WHEREAS, The California Legislature enacted AB 471 (Chapter 106 of the Statutes of 1989), which is intended to provide \$10 million annually for a period of 10 years for grants to local, state and federal agencies and nonprofit entities for projects to enhance and mitigate the environmental impacts of modified or new public transportation facilities; and,

WHEREAS, Tulare Park is located adjacent to the Illinois Street Intermodal Bridge project and is eligible for AB 471 funds by virtue of its relationship to this project; and,

WHEREAS, On June 7, 2007, the Port was allocated \$275,000 in AB 471 funds from the California Resources Agency, Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation Program for improvements to Tulare Park, including ADA accessibility requirements, as well as connections to other open spaces, re-landscaping, and installation of new park amenities, including benches, lighting, signage and trash receptacles; and,

WHEREAS, On May 8, 2007, through Commission Resolution No. 07-34, the Port Commission authorized the Executive Director of the Port to enter into an agreement with the California Resources Agency to accept and expend these grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; and.

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WHEREAS, The Port Commission proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Port Commission to accept and expend \$275,000 in AB 471 grant funds from the California Resources Agency for ADA and other improvements to Tulare Park; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the Port to execute any documents required for the implementation of this grant, including any amendments, augmentations or extensions thereof; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Executive Director of the Port, or her designee, is authorized to approve, sign and execute an agreement to hold the granting agency harmless from liability arising out of the Project.
