Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$660,000 in Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds through the Federal Emergency Management Agency to seismically retrofit the Millbrae Water Supply & Treatment Headquarters.

WHEREAS, The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), through its agent, the Governor's Office of Emergency Services of the State of California (Cal OES), is authorized to provide funding through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) under Section 404 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) staff submitted an application requesting \$660,000 in FEMA HMGP funds to seismically retrofit and upgrade the Millbrae Water Supply & Treatment (WST) Headquarters to meet current codes and standards for seismic safety; and,

WHEREAS, The Millbrae WST Headquarters is designated as the Emergency

Operations Center (EOC) for the Regional Water System after an earthquake event; and,

WHEREAS, FEMA, through its agent Cal OES, notified the SFPUC on May 31, 2007 that it had approved a grant award of \$660,000 in FEMA HMGP funds for the Millbrae WST Headquarters Seismic Retrofit; and

WHEREAS, The required matching funds are available through Project No. CUW210; and

WHEREAS, In compliance with both the California Environmental Quality Act and the National Environmental Policy Act, the project is Categorically Excluded (CATEX) from the need to prepare either an environmental assessment or environmental impact statement; and

WHEREAS, The grant budget does not allow for indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission on June 26 2007, adopted resolution no. 070123 authorizing the General Manager to request permission from the Board of Supervisors to accept and expend FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, or designee, is authorized to accept and expend \$660,000 in FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds for the aforementioned project and to execute all required agreements; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget.
