Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to submit an interim progress report (IPR) in order to continue to receive funding for the HIV Prevention Projects grant from the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The amount of this annual recurring grant for the next grant year (January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008) is expected to be approximately \$9 million. The due date of the IPR is September 4, 2007.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors passed Ordinance No. 265-05 in November 2005, amending Section 10-170 of the Administrative Code to require Board review of proposed annual or otherwise recurring grant applications of \$5,000,000 or more prior to their submission; and,

WHEREAS, DPH is currently a recipient of the HIV Prevention Programs grant in the amount of \$9,019,618 from the CDC; and,

WHEREAS, DPH uses these funds to cover a multitude of HIV prevention programs for San Francisco residents, with 35 percent of the total award amount used for administrative costs (including planning, evaluation, coordination of programs, and contract management) and the remaining 65 percent is subcontracted to qualified contractors selected through RFP to provide direct services to clients; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 265-05 requires that City Departments submit applications for approval at least 60 days prior to the grant deadline for review and approval; and,

WHEREAS, The CDC released the application announcement on July 3, with a due date of September 4 allowing just 63 days for the entire process; and,
