[Authorization for City to enter into Memorandum of Understanding with other Bay Areas cities and counties to govern expenditure of federal homeland security funds for fiscal year 2007 and future fiscal years, and to make San Francisco primary grantee and fiscal agent.]

Resolution authorizing City and County officials to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding that (1) establishes procedures for application, allocation and distribution of federal Urban Areas Security Initiative Program grant funds for fiscal year 2007 and future fiscal years, (2) continues an Urban Area Working Group with other Bay Area governmental entities, and (3) continues San Francisco as the primary grantee and fiscal agent for Urban Areas Security Initiative Program grant funds; further authorizing designated City and County officials to negotiate, execute and file on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco any and all agreements and documents and to take any other action necessary to apply for and receive grant funds under the federal Urban Areas Security Initiatives Program.

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Homeland Security ("DHS") has a Homeland Security Grant Program, which includes the Urban Areas Security Initiative ("UASI") Program. The UASI Program addresses the unique planning, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density Urban Areas, and assists those areas in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from threats and acts of terrorism; and,

WHEREAS, On January 3, 2006, DHS combined the separate Urban Areas of the City and County of San Francisco, the City of Oakland, and the City of San Jose into a single, combined Bay Area Urban Area ("SUASI region") for the purposes of application for and distribution of fiscal year 2006 UASI Program grant funds. The SUASI region includes the ten

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contiguous Bay Area counties and other Bay Area governmental jurisdictions within those counties; and

WHEREAS, DHS distributes UASI Program grant funds to the California Governor's Office of Homeland Security ("OHS"), which administers the UASI Program within the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, All UASI Program grant funds awarded to the SUASI region must conform to all applicable federal and state grant and contracting requirements; and,

WHEREAS, For the UASI Program, DHS requires each Urban Area receiving funds to establish an Urban Area Working Group ("UAWG") to act as an executive steering committee and provide overall governance of the UASI Program across the regional area encompassed within the defined Urban Area, to coordinate development and implementation of all UASI Program initiatives within the SUASI region, and to ensure that all programmatic requirements associated with participation in the UASI Program are fulfilled; and,

WHEREAS, For fiscal year 2006, the City and County of San Francisco, the City of Oakland, the City of San Jose, Alameda County, and Santa Clara County jointly committed to cooperate for the purposes of applying for, allocating and distributing the fiscal year 2006 UASI Program grant funds, and accordingly entered a Memorandum of Understanding dated July 1, 2006 ("2006 MOU") setting forth their agreements regarding the SUASI region mission, governance structure, responsibilities, reporting structure and financial arrangements, and establishing structures, processes and mechanisms to use in applying for, allocating and distributing UASI Program grant funding for the SUASI region; and,

WHEREAS, The 2006 MOU created a SUASI Region Approval Authority, comprised of representatives from City and County of San Francisco, the City of Oakland, the City of San

Jose, Alameda County, and Santa Clara County. The 2006 MOU also established an Advisory Group and a Management Team to support and assist the Approval Authority; and,

WHEREAS, DHS and OHS approved the Approval Authority and related layers of governance structure created in the 2006 MOU as the UAWG for the SUASI region; and,

WHEREAS, For the UASI Program, DHS required the UAWG to develop a methodology for allocating funds available through the UASI Program; and,

WHEREAS, The 2006 MOU established procedures for allocating UASI funds throughout the SUASI region, designated the City and County of San Francisco as the primary grantee of UASI funds for the SUASI region, and designated San Francisco as the fiscal agent for the Approval Authority; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved the 2006 MOU in Resolution No. 718-06, File No. 061583; and,

WHEREAS, DHS continued the SUASI region structure and UAWG requirement for application and distribution of UASI Program grant funds in fiscal year 2007; and,

WHEREAS, The parties to the 2006 MOU agreed to renew and where appropriate update that agreement with regard to the SUASI region mission, governance structure, responsibilities, reporting structure and financial arrangements; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, the City of Oakland, the City of San Jose, Alameda County, and Santa Clara County developed an updated Memorandum of Understanding dated July 1, 2007 ("2007 MOU") setting structures, processes and mechanisms to apply for, allocate and distribute UASI Program grant funding for the SUASI region for fiscal year 2007 and future fiscal years; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of the 2007 MOU is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. __071451_____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The OHS requires that the governing bodies of the parties to the 2007 MOU set forth in a resolution the agents authorized to execute all documents needed to apply for and receive grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has participated in federal and state homeland security grant programs since their inception, and deems participation in those programs as vital to the continued well being of its citizens; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding Between the City and County of San Francisco, the City of Oakland, the City of San Jose, Alameda County; and Santa Clara County, dated July 1, 2007, which MOU (1) continues the Approval Authority as the UAWG for the SUASI region, (2) authorizes the Approval Authority to determine the distribution of UASI funds for the SUASI region for fiscal year 2007 and future fiscal years; and (3) designates San Francisco as the primary grantee and fiscal agent for UASI grant funds for the SUASI region for fiscal years; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Controller of the City and County of San Francisco and the Director of the Department of Emergency Management, or their designees, to execute for and on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco any agreements, applications, assurances, certificates and other documents and to take any additional actions necessary to obtain federal and state homeland security grant funding under the UASI Program and any other federal or state homeland security grant funding, for fiscal year 2007 and future fiscal years.
