WHEREAS, The North American Bridge Championships will be held in San Francisco from November 23 to December 1; and

WHEREAS, The USA 1 Women's Bridge Team, Gail Greenberg, Debbie Rosenberg, Jill Levin, Irina Levitina, Hansa Narasimhan, JoAnna Stansby and Jill Meyers won the Venice Cup in Shanghai in October 12, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, The team includes women who have been pioneers for gender equality in bridge; and,

WHEREAS, The team held up a small sign at the Venice Cup awards ceremony distancing themselves from the election of President Bush; and,

WHEREAS, On returning to the United States they have been accused of treason and sedition; and,

WHEREAS, The United State Bridge Federation, heretofore USBF, is considering sanctions against the seven women, including suspension of from federation events for one year, community service, and an apology drafted by the federation's lawyer; and,

WHEREAS, Many of the women rely on bridge for their livelihood; and WHEREAS, The USBF will be commencing a hearing on the matter Thursday, November 29 in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The New York Times Editorial Board has called "this sort of censorship un-American, unsporting and counterproductive"; and noted that, "it will only confirm the fartoo-common belief that America is no longer committed to free speech — or fair play"; and,

WHEREAS, Freedom of speech is a fundamental value of our City and central to democracy; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors welcomes the American Contract Bridge League to San Francisco for the North American Bridge Championships; and, be it
