(2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee. (3) The petitioner shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (4) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand")

idly about, linger aimlessly without lawful business) is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee. (5) The sale of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited. (6) No person under the age of twenty-one (21) years of age shall sell, furnish or deliver alcoholic beverages. (7) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday. (8) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed.
