2 AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN
3 FRANCISCO TO RETROACTIVELY ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF
4 \$220,000 FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR A
5 PROGRAM ENTITLED "ANTI-GANG INITIATIVE / PROJECT SEARCH & RESCUE".

7 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police for the City and County of San
8 Francisco desires to undertake a certain project designated "ANTI-
9 GANG INITIATIVE / PROJECT SEARCH & RESCUE", to be funded from funds
10 made available through the Governor's Office of Emergency Services;
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, The intent of this program will be to conduct
13 spontaneous and unannounced searches on eligible probationers to
14 deter further criminal activity; and,

15 WHEREAS, The project will also seek to rescue children from
16 being exposed to drug dealers in public areas within 1000 feet of
17 their schools; and,

18 WHEREAS the grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

19 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs
20 of \$2909; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police for the City and County of
22 San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San
23 Francisco to retroactively accept and expend continued funding for
24 this project from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services; and be

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and
2 County of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the
3 City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Agreement for
4 this project including any extensions, funding augmentations from the
5 Governor's Office of Emergency Services, or amendments thereof; and
6 be it


7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising

9 actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and
10 the authorizing agency; and be it

12 be used to supplant expenditure controlled by the Board of
13 Supervisors.
