Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$468,469 from the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Emergency Preparedness Office, to fund the Hospital Preparedness Program; for the period of September 1, 2007 through August 8, 2008.

WHEREAS, CDPH's Emergency Preparedness Office has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of \$468,469 for the Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP), for the period of September 1, 2007 through August 8, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, This grant funds the planning and coordination of hospital preparedness activities for health care facilities in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds CDPH requires DPH to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ______, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for one existing position, Health Program Planner (Job Class #2818), .50 FTE; and,

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because CDPH was delayed in sending the required paperwork to the counties (this funding is an appropriation predetermined by per capita rates and is not competitive); and,

WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$61,105; now therefore, be it
