

1 [Accept and expend grant funds to support a juvenile mental health program.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the United States**
5 **Department of Justice, for a project entitled "AIIM Higher," for the period of September**
6 **1, 2008 through August 31, 2010.**

8 WHEREAS, DPH is the recipient of a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office
9 of Justice Programs in the amount of \$200,000 to conduct the SF AIIM Higher project, for the
10 period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2010; and,

11 WHEREAS, The SF AIIM (Assess, Identify Needs, Integrate Information, and Match
12 to Services) Higher program will serve a total of 400 youth with moderate to serious risks and
13 mental health needs at San Francisco's Juvenile Justice Center and the Log Cabin Ranch;
14 and,

15 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
16 for one existing position for the period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2010, at .70
17 FTE to be filled by either a Psychiatric Social Worker (Job Class #2930) or a Marriage,
18 Family, & Child Counselor (Job Class #2931); and,

19 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
20 receive the award letter and agreement from the funder until September 2, 2008 with a project
21 start date of September 1, 2008; and,

22 WHEREAS, The budget does include matching funds in the amount of \$50,000, or
23 \$25,000 per year, an in-kind contribution of facility expenses and personnel costs; and,

24 WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs because the
25 U.S. Department of Justice does not allow it; now therefore, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
8 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it


9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
10 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
12 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
13 the agreement expires.
