WHEREAS, the City entered into an agreement with Contractor, dated October 1, 2007, to be the backup provider for gasoline and diesel fuel; and,

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor entered into the First Amendment to the contract on September 5, 2008, to change the Contractor from being the backup provider for City departments in the Bay Area to being the primary provider for the Municipal Transportation Authority, the Fire Department, and the Public Utilities Commission, and the backup provider for all other City departments in the Bay Area; and,

WHEREAS, Purchasing believes spending could approach \$10 million by approximately December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Purchasing will conduct a competitive bid for a successor contract with the goal of having the successor contract in place on or before May 1, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, Purchasing proposes to amend the contract to change its dollar limit to \$20 million to accommodate estimated spending between now and May 1, 2009; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors approves the second amendment to the agreement, changing the dollar amount to \$20 million.
