Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license from 232 O'Farrell Street to 115 Mason Street (District 6), to John D. Smith for Union Square Sports Bar Inc., will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, with conditions.

WHEREAS, John D. Smith is seeking the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license from 232 O'Farrell Street to 115 Mason Street (District 6), for Union Square Sports Bar Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license to John D. Smith for Union Square Sports Bar Inc., located at 115 Mason Street, will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

Conditions: (1) The sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. daily. (2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee. (3) No person under the age of twenty-one (21 years of age) shall sell and/or furnish alcoholic beverages. (4) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited. (5)

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Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business) is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257. (6) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (7) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday. (8) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. (9) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed. (10) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences. Any illuminated signage on the exterior of the premises shall also be maintained in such a manner as not to disturb any neighboring residences. (11) At no time shall any person under the age of 21 years enter or remain in these public premises. (12) The premises shall maintain at least two surveillance cameras in operational condition at all times when this premises is open to the public. At a minimum, one camera shall monitor the interior and the other the exterior of the premises. Said cameras shall maintain a recording of events and recordings shall be maintained for a minimum of two (2) weeks. These recordings shall be made available to law enforcement upon request. (13) During all hours that this premises is open to the public a security guard shall be on-site.

Said guard shall be dressed in a manner as to make him/her easily identifiable as security to the general public. (14) All employees shall attend ABC Licensee Education on Alcohol and Drugs (LEAD) classes. (15) These licensed premises shall not expand its business on to the sidewalks. The use of tables or chairs in front of these premises would constitute a violation of this condition. (16) Other than the use of the licensed premises name, "Union Square Sports Bar," there shall be no exterior advertising or sign of any kind or type, including advertising directed to the exterior from within, promoting or indicated the availability of alcoholic beverages. Interior displays of alcoholic beverages or signs which are clearly visible to the exterior shall constitute a violation of this condition.
