[Resolution adopting findings related to San Francisco Public Utilities Commission Water System Improvement Program (WSIP) Alameda Siphon No. 4 Project.]

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Resolution adopting findings under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), CEQA Guidelines, and San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31, including the adoption of a mitigation monitoring and reporting program, related to the funding of the Alameda Siphon No. 4 Project, and directing the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to notify the Controller of this action.

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WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) developed project descriptions for water infrastructure improvements as part of the SFPUC's Water System Improvement Program (WSIP) for the Alameda Siphon No. 4 Project, WSIP Funded Project No. CUW35902, (the "Project"), and

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WHEREAS, The objectives of the Project are to increase the water delivery reliability of the regional water system; and

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WHEREAS, A draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Project was prepared and published for public review on February 13, 2008; and

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WHEREAS, Public comments on the Draft IS/MND were received between February 13, 2008 and March 13, 2008; and

WHEREAS. On May 5, 2008, the Planning Department reviewed and considered the

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IS/MND and found that the contents of said report and the procedures through which the IS/MND was prepared, publicized and reviewed complied with the California Environmental

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Quality Act (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.) (CEQA), 14 California

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Code of Regulations Sections 15000 et seq. (the "CEQA Guidelines") and Chapter 31 of the

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San Francisco Administrative Code ("Chapter 31"); the Planning Department found the

WHEREAS, No appeals were filed with the City and County of San Francisco regarding the Project's MND; the May 5, 2008 MND is final, complete, and in accordance with CEQA, the CEQA Guidelines, and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code (Final IS/MND); and

IS/MND was adequate, accurate and objective, reflected the independent analysis and

judgment of the Department, and that the summary of comments and responses contained no

significant revisions to the Draft IS/MND, adopted findings of no significant impacts associated

with the Project and adopted the IS/MND in Planning Department File No. 2006.0776E; and

WHEREAS, The SFPUC reviewed and considered the information contained in the Final IS/MND, all written and oral information provided by the Planning Department, the public, relevant public agencies, SFPUC and other experts and the administrative files for the WSIP and the Final IS/MND; and

WHEREAS, On July 8, 2008, at a public meeting of the SFPUC, the SFPUC adopted Resolution No. 08- 0120, in which the SFPUC: (1) adopted CEQA Findings and the Final IS/MND and, adopted the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP), which SFPUC Resolution and Attachments are incorporated herein as part of this Resolution by this reference thereto, and (2) approved the Project and authorized staff to proceed with actions necessary to implement the Project. SFPUC Resolution No. 08-0120, which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. __090281, including its findings, is incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth; and

WHEREAS, The SFPUC CEQA Findings reflected the SFPUC's independent review and consideration of the relevant environmental information contained in the Final IS/MND, the administrative record and Addendum; and

WHEREAS, On January 5, 2009 the SFPUC submitted project revisions (Revised Project) to the Planning Department and requested environmental review, and

WHEREAS, On February 23, 2009, the Planning Department published an Addendum to the 2008 Final IS/MND that determined that the revised project would not cause new significant environmental impacts not previously identified in the Final IS/MND nor would it substantially increase the severity of impacts previously identified in the Final IS/MND, and

WHEREAS, This Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 311-08, approving a supplemental appropriation of \$1,923,629,194 for the WSIP, and adopting related CEQA Findings based on 1) the Water System Improvement Program Final Environmental Impact Report (WSIP Final EIR), certified by Planning Commission by its Motion No. 17734, and 2) SFPUC Resolution Nos. 08-0200 and 08-0202 in which the SFPUC: (A) approved the Phased Water System Improvement Program (Phased WSIP) and (B) authorized the request for the Supplemental Appropriation; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 311-08 placed the appropriated funds on Controller's Appropriation Reserve, by project, making release of appropriation reserves by the Controller subject to the prior occurrence of:1) the SFPUC's and the Board's discretionary adoption of CEQA Findings for projects, following review and consideration of completed project-related environmental analysis, pursuant to CEQA, the State CEQA Guidelines, and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, where required, and 2) the Controller's certification of funds availability, including proceeds of indebtedness. The ordinance also placed any project with costs in excess of \$100 million on Budget and Finance Committee reserve pending review and reserve release by that Committee. The costs for the Alameda Siphons project are less than the \$100 million threshold, however, this project was combined with the proposed New Irvington Tunnel project for purposes of the supplemental appropriation, and together the

two projects exceed the threshold. Therefore, the SFPUC has sent a letter to the Budget and Finance Committee requesting review and release of the portion of those funds necessary for the Alameda Siphons No. 4 project; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes and adopts the findings set forth in "Attachment A" to this Resolution, "California Environmental Quality Act Findings For San Francisco Board Of Supervisors Resolution Authorizing Funding For Implementation Of The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's Alameda Siphon No. 4 Project"; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors adopts the IS/MND. as modified by the February 23, 2009 Addendum, and adopts the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, as modified by the February 23, 2009 Addendum; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to forward this Resolution to the Controller.
