Resolution supporting Senate Bill 585 to Ban Gun Shows at the Cow Palace.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 585 would prohibit the sale of firearms and ammunition at the Cow Palace; and,

WHEREAS, Since 2005, communities adjacent to the Cow Palace, including the Sunnydale public housing project and neighborhoods of Visitacion Valley, Bayview-Hunters Point, and the Mission have dealt with 44% of the homicides in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS. More than 30% of the guns seized in the City and County of San Francisco came from these communities; and,

WHEREAS, In 2003, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors unanimously passed a resolution urging the state to ban gun shows from the Cow Palace; and,

WHEREAS, Promoters continue to host gun shows on state property in the Cow Palace and,

WHEREAS, In recent years, counties across California, including Alameda, Marin, San Mateo, and Los Angeles counties, have banned gun shows at county-owned facilities in their jurisdictions; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 585 solves residents' calls and resolutions passed unanimously by San Mateo and San Francisco Counties to discontinue gun shows on state property; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco supports Senate Bill 585 to ban gun shows at the Cow Palace.
