[Approval of Software License and Software Maintenance contracts between the Department of Public Health and Philips Healthcare for the upgrade of the Philips CareVue critical care documentation system to the Philips IntelliVue Clinical Information Portfolio (ICIP) System]

Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to enter into a Software License and Software Maintenance contract with Philips Healthcare.

WHEREAS, the current critical care patient information system (CareVue Chart) manufactured by Philips Healthcare is no longer supported by Philips Healthcare; and

WHEREAS, after an extensive review by both Clinical and Information Technology staff the Department has determined that an upgrade to the new Philips ICIP system is in the best interest of the Department and for overall patient care; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission has approved the two contracts; and,

WHEREAS, Section 21.21 of the Administrative code requires that vendors fully indemnify the City for all claims of intellectual property infringement; and

WHEREAS, the Software License and related Software Maintenance contracts do not provide the City with full indemnification from Intellectual Property infringement claims; and,

WHEREAS, the Department and Philips Healthcare have negotiated a cap on intellectual property infringement indemnification which will limit the liability of Philips Healthcare to \$1,500,000 excluding the City's legal cost for defending an infringement suit, for any claim of Intellectual Property infringement; and

WHEREAS, Philips Healthcare has certified that the proposed system has never had an Intellectual Property infringement claim against it; and

WHEREAS, that any contract that does not full comply with the requirements of Administrative Code Section 21.21 requires a resolution from the Board of Supervisors approving such contracts; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Public Health and the Office of Contract Administration on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to enter into Software License and Software Maintenance contracts with Philips Healthcare for the upgrade to the Philips ICIP system as set forth in file number 090323.
