[Declaring Van Ness Avenue and Geary Boulevard Bus Rapid Transits as San Francisco's Top Federal Small Starts Funding Priority]

Resolution declaring Van Ness Avenue Bus Rapid Transit and Geary Boulevard Bus Rapid Transit as San Francisco's top and sole priorities priority for Federal Small Starts Funding

WHEREAS, the Proposition K local transportation sales tax Expenditure Plan, approved by San Francisco voters in 2003, identifies Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) on Van Ness Avenue and Geary Boulevard as signature investments; and

WHEREAS, the 2004 San Francisco Countywide Transportation Plan identifies a network of BRT routes, including one on Van Ness Avenue and one on Geary Boulevard, as the preferred transportation investment alternative to meet long range transportation needs through 2030; and

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, in adopting Resolution 3434, the Regional Transit Expansion Policy, identified \$600,000 for a study of BRT feasibility on Geary Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, with the support of each project's Citizens Advisory Committee, the San Francisco County Transportation Authority (Authority) Board and the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Board adopted the Van Ness Avenue BRT Feasibility Study and the Geary BRT Feasibility Study, in 2006 and 2007 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Studies found that BRT is feasible on Van Ness Avenue and Geary Boulevard and recommended proceeding with the next steps in environmental review and project development; and

WHEREAS, the Authority appropriated \$1,950,000 in Proposition K to support environmental studies and preliminary engineering of Van Ness Avenue BRT, in January 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Authority applied for, and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) granted entry into Project Development for the Van Ness Avenue BRT project in December 2007; and

WHEREAS, the FTA rated Van Ness Avenue BRT "high" for cost-effectiveness and "medium-high" overall as a Small Starts candidate project; making Van Ness BRT the highest ranked BRT project in the country for Small Starts funding; and

WHEREAS, the Authority appropriated \$2,308,000 in Prop K to support environmental studies and preliminary engineering of Geary Boulevard BRT in June 2008, and intends to seek entry into Project Development for the Geary BRT project in August 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Authority and SFMTA have signed Memoranda Of Understanding (MOU) in August 2008, and October 2008, establishing the Van Ness Avenue BRT and Geary Boulevard BRT projects as shared agency priorities for near-term development; and

WHEREAS, On September 24, 2008, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) added the Van Ness Bus Rapid Transit project to the Regional Transit Expansion

Policy (MTC Resolution 3434), which sets regional priorities for transportation funds, and named the project as one of two regional priorities for federal Small Starts Funds; and

WHEREAS, On April 22, 2009, the MTC Metropolitan Transportation Commission adopted Transportation 2035, the new Regional Transportation Plan for the Bay Area, which includes both the Van Ness and Geary Bus Rapid Transit projects in the financially constrained project list and positions both projects very favorably to receive state and federal funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Authority hereby declares Van Ness Avenue BRT and Geary Boulevard BRT as San Francisco's top and sole priorities priority for Small Starts funding, and urges the Authority and the MTA to vigorously pursue Small Starts funding for final design and implementation of these projects, and to advocate for these projects at the regional, state, and federal levels.
