WHEREAS, The CDC is supporting DPH's HIV Epidemiology Section participation in the MMP; in the amount of \$402,342, for the period of June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The CDC is allocating funds annually but intends to fund the project for five years if the grantee's progress is satisfactory, in which case DPH will get a total of \$2,178,238 for five years; and,

WHEREAS, The MMP is a comprehensive population-based project to gather detailed information on HIV-infected patients receiving care in the United States; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco was announced as one of the study sites in the CDC grant announcement (Funding Opportunity No. PS09-937) released March 9, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses DPH for one existing position, Manager 1 (Job Class 0922) at .05 FTE for the period of June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The budget includes \$392,484 in contractual services, which will be paid to the Public Health Foundation Enterprises through a sole source contract; and,

WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$1,501; now therefore, be it
