

1 [Contract to rehabilitate 16 PCC historic streetcars.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to enter into a contract**
4 **with Brookville Equipment Corporation to rehabilitate 16 PCC historic streetcars for an**
5 **amount not to exceed \$18,712,576, and a term not to exceed five years.**

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7 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) operates
8 the Municipal Railway (Muni), which has 24 historic streetcars in revenue service; and,

9 WHEREAS, The popularity of the F-line and planned future expansion service require
10 Muni to add Presidential Conference Committee (PCC) streetcars to its historic streetcar fleet;
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, On July 8, 2008, the SFMTA issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for
13 Contract No. 583-03, Complete Rehabilitation of 16 PCC Historic Streetcars, and received two
14 proposals in response to the RFP; and,

15 WHEREAS, After reviewing the proposals and conducting oral interviews, the selection
16 committee ranked Brookville Equipment Corporation as the highest qualified proposer; and,

17 WHEREAS, On June 16, 2009, the SFMTA Board of Directors adopted Resolution No.
18 09-099, which authorized the Executive Director/CEO of the SFMTA to execute Contract No.
19 583-03 with Brookville Equipment Corporation, for an amount not to exceed \$18,712,576, and
20 a term not to exceed five years; and,

21 WHEREAS, A copy of said contract is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
22 in File No.090907; which is hereby declared to be a part of this motion as if set forth fully
23 herein; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the SFMTA to enter into a
2 contract with Brookville Equipment Corporation to rehabilitate 16 PCC historic streetcars for
3 an amount not to exceed \$18,712,576, and a term not to exceed five years.
