3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$2,151,772 from the California**
5 **Department of Public Health (CDPH), to assist with a project entitled “Public Health**
6 **Emergency Response;” for the period of July 31, 2009 through July 30, 2010.**

8 WHEREAS, CDPH is the recipient of a grant award from the Centers for Disease
9 Control and Prevention (CDC) and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)
10 Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP) to support the project entitled “Public Health
11 Emergency Response;” and,

12 WHEREAS, Through this grant, CDPH has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of
13 \$2,151,772 for the period of July 31, 2009 through July 30, 2010; and,

14 WHEREAS, DPH will subcontract with Circle Point and the San Francisco Study
15 Center, for a total amount of \$94,890 for the period of July 31, 2009 through July 30, 2010;
16 and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDPH requires the City to
18 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
19 Board of Supervisors in File No. 091423; which is hereby declared to be a part of
20 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

21 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
22 for eighteen existing positions, including one Physician Specialist (job class #2230) at 0.38
23 FTE, one Senior Physician Specialist (job class #2232) at 0.36 FTE, one Health Program
24 Coordinator II (job class #2591) at 0.52 FTE, one Health Program Coordinator II (job class
25 #2591) at 0.25 FTE, one Health Program Coordinator I (job class #2589) at 0.44 FTE, one

10 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
11 receive the signed agreements until mid-October; and,

12 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs for one year in the
13 amount of \$141,493; and,

14 WHEREAS, DPH respectfully requests that the Board of Supervisors expedite their
15 decision because the approved grant agreement must be submitted to CDPH by December
16 30, 2009; failure to meet this deadline will result in re-allocation of CDPH funds to other local
17 health departments; now therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant retroactively
19 in the amount of \$2,151,772 from CDPH; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
21 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
22 be it


23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
