WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from the CDFA in the amount of \$37,787 for a project entitled High Risk Program; for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of this grant is to prevent infestation of pests from incoming high-risk shipments of plan material from Hawaii, Florida, and other southern states by performing high-risk pest exclusion activities at nurseries or nursery holding facilities; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses DPH for four existing positions: two Agricultural Inspectors (job class 3450) at 0.30 FTE, one Manager I (job class 0922) at 0.05 FTE, and one Junior Administrative Analyst (job class 1820) at 0.02 FTE, for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$6,193.59; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$37,787 from the CDFA; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the agreement expires; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
