Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health to accept and expend retroactively a grant from the California Department of Public Health in the amount of \$320,367 to fund the California Colon Cancer Control Health Program; for the period May 1, 2010, through June 30, 2013.

WHEREAS, CDPH is the recipient of a grant award from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to support the project entitled "California Colon Cancer Health Program;" and,

WHEREAS, Through this grant, CDPH has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of \$320,367 for the period of May 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to provide colorectal cancer screening to low-income men and women who are uninsured or underinsured; and,

WHEREAS, DPH will subcontract with Polymedco, in the amount of \$55,000 for the period of May 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for three existing positions, two Health Worker I (Job Class #2585) at 0.50 FTE and one IS Programmer Analyst-Senior (Job Class #1063) at 0.50 FTE, for the period of May 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, The funding level from CDPH may be expanded to fund additional colorectal cancer screening centers; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$26,452; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the agreement expires; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
